

ORGANISED PLAY GUIDE FOR STORES & TOs



On behalf of Let's Play Games and TAK Games, thank you for being a part of our Organised Play Network in Australia for Bandai's Dragon Ball Super TCG. Collectible card games live and die on the strength of the supporting community. As a tournament organiser, you fill an exceptionally important role in providing players with a safe competitive environment to play.

This guide assists tournament organisers understand player registration requirements, the organised play software utilised and general guidelines for running a successful store event.

PLAYER REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY

Players must be registered on a TAK Games Player Registration card to participate in leader board rankings. The TAK Games Player Registration card can be completed online at <http://www.tak-games.com.au/organised-play/player-registration/>.

Players that have not registered formally with TAK Games will continue to accumulate points for their participation but will not be eligible for any additional prizes until their registration is complete.

SETTING UP YOUR EVENT IN CHALLENGE

All sanctioned tournament events for the TAK Games Organised Play Network are run via Challenge under the Australian Bandai Dragon Ball Super network (<http://dbsuperaustralia.challenge.com/>) You will need to register for a Challenge ID and provide that ID to TAK Games for you to be added as an organiser. Please email dbsuper@tak-games.com.au with your Challenge ID and store name.

Once you have been confirmed as a tournament organiser, you're ready to start registering sanctioned events!

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Please follow these steps to set up your Dragon Ball Super tournament event. This should be completed on the day of your tournament event.

Step 1

Log in to Challonge.com using your ID. Click **Organisations**, and select **Australian Bandai Dragon Ball Super TCG Network** from the drop down menu.

Click “New Tournament” to begin creating your event.



Step 2

You will now be asked for tournament details. The name of your event needs to follow this format:

Please list the Game as Bandai Dragon Ball Super Card Game.

Local store events should use the **Single Stage** tournament type. Select **Swiss** format, and enter 3.0 points for a win, 1.5 points for a tie and 3.0 points for a bye.

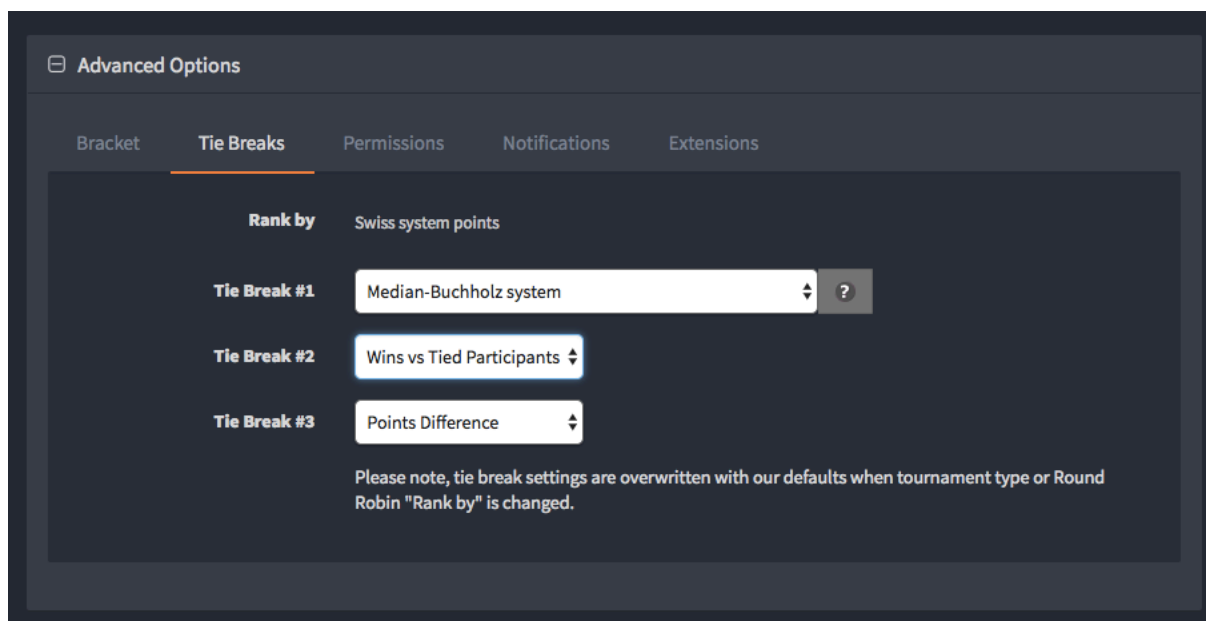

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Click “Advanced Options” and copy the settings below.

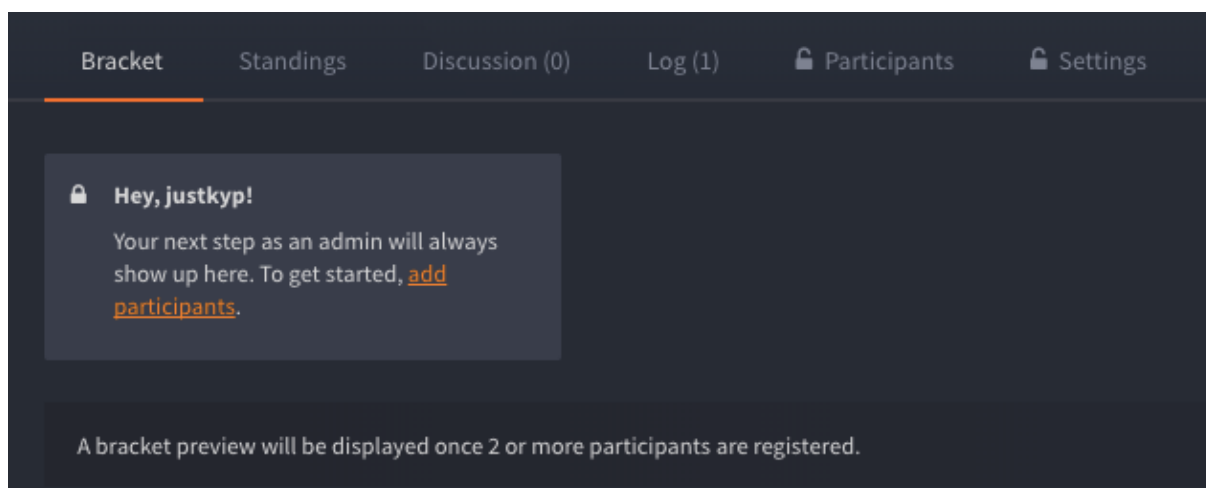


Click “Save and Continue” to finalise your event.

Congratulations! Your tournament will now be listed under the Australian Bandai Dragon Ball Super organisation.

Step 3

You can now run your event within Challenge. To get started, add participants. Please use full names for players, as well as their Challenge username if known.



Challenge will step you through the rest of the way to report results and finalise your event.

Provided your tournament meets sanctioning requirements (8 player minimum participation), your event will count towards player rankings.

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ORGANISED PLAY SUPPORT

Tournament kits will be provided on a monthly basis for stores running regular events, and stores may receive up to two free tournament kits per month.

Stores qualify for a free tournament kit if:

- they have run a sanctioned, reported event in the preceding month; and
- they have purchased at least \$400 in Bandai Dragon Ball Super products in the preceding month.

Stores may receive a second complimentary tournament kit in a calendar month if they record events with a combined total participation of 16 players.

Tournament kits will be automatically sent out by Let's Play Games. If you require more than two tournament kits in a calendar month, please contact us and we can review your requirements.

Budokai Card Club promos are also available on a monthly basis. These allow stores to run casual league events with every participant receiving an exclusive, unique promo card.

GUIDELINES FOR TOURNAMENTS

Tournament rulings should be guided by the official rulebook included in every Starter Deck in addition to the Current Rulings Document and Frequently Asked Questions provided on the official Bandai Dragon Ball Super website at <http://www.dbs-cardgame.com/>
